Ad. 5

How do we ensure an open dialogue at the department and is there anything we can do to improve?

2 months ago a bench fee was implemented at the department. When agreed in the IGT Leadership Group this should have afterwards been discussed at the department council. JESC informed that when implementing things in the future, we will aim (when possible) to present topics and initiatives at the department council early in the process. This to ensure a higher level of involvement and participation.

Other areas also makes sense to discuss at department council level before involving the rest of the organisation. Once discussions have taken place, or have been presented, at the department council it will also be easier for the leadership to defend the decisions taken.

Forward-looking the leadership group will have increased focus on involving the department council and staff members in general. JESC noted that increased involvement and participation can also take place at unit/section meetings.

Concerning the agendas for the department council meetings JESC mentioned that most often we don't receive any input from any members of the council. All members of the



council were reminded that as representatives you each have the responsibility to ask among fellow colleaugues and students if they have any topics or input they would like you to bring to the council. Forward-looking we should focus on making ourselves, and the existence of the department council, more visible.
