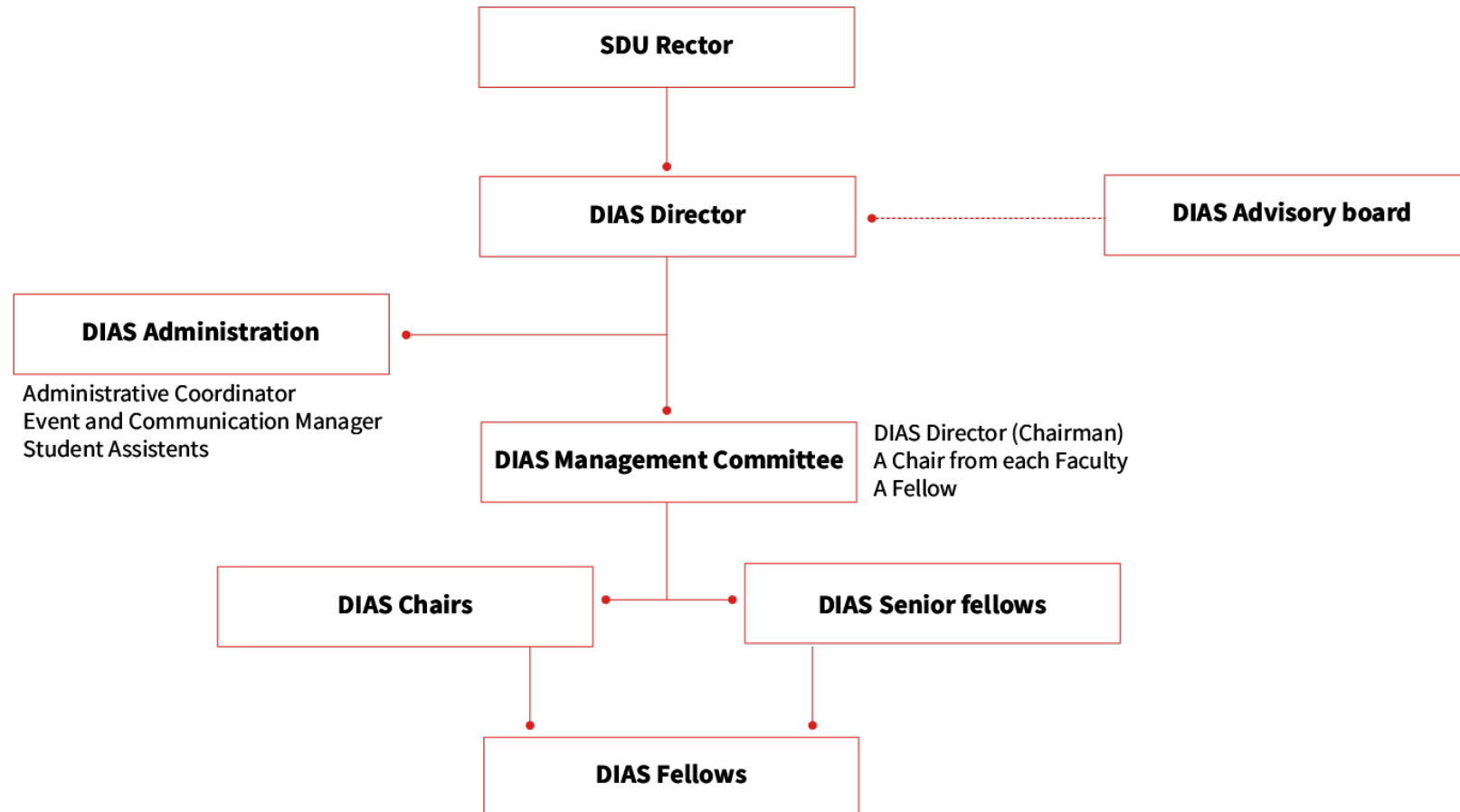
Mission

DIAS People

- **DIAS Chairs (20)**
 - Exceptional, established researchers at Professor-level at SDU – *target: 30 Chairs*.
- **External DIAS Chairs (6)**
 - Exceptional, established researchers at Professor-level – *target: 10 external Chairs*.
- **DIAS Senior Fellows (8)**
 - Highly talented researchers (Associate Professor or Professor-level) appointed at SDU with obvious potential to become exceptional researchers (DIAS Chairs).
- **DIAS Fellows (18)**
 - Talented, promising Assistant Professors recruited to SDU

DIAS Fellows

- Talented, promising assistant professors recruited to great research environments at SDU, and affiliated at DIAS.
- Every Faculty is obliged to reserve funds to at least five simultaneous positions as assistant professor after agreement with the Executive Board.
- The researcher is appointed for four years with possibility for two years renewal as associate professor.

The purpose of DIAS Fellows

- To recruit, support and retain young, international, excellent researchers.

DIAS lectures every Wednesday 12.15 – 13.15

- **Purpose:** to create an environment where researchers from DIAS and SDU can network and have academic discussions across research fields.
- Four times a semester exceptional, international researchers are invited – the remaining Wednesday's talented researchers present their newest research and ideas.
