**Evaluation strategy for the education:**

**Positive examples for inspiration:**

Specific course on 2<sup>nd</sup> semester: Students seem to have a general and positive view on the course, with well-organized, great structure. Regarding design crits and feedback sessions, the students are hoping for the sessions to be more focused on giving/receiving critical, constructive feedback – that is facilitated/guided by the instructor, and peer-to-peer.

Overall semester/Year feel (2<sup>nd</sup> semester): Students have overall positive feedback of the semester with manageable courses that provide a variety of choices and a strong sense of agency.

**Conditions that call for further follow-up:**

Overall semester/Year feel (2<sup>nd</sup> semester): Students express that parallel courses/ projects overlapping become overwhelming and hard to distribute focus and workload throughout the semester. Students also express that social life in the class tends to 'fall apart', resulting in demotivation to attend classes.

**Future initiatives based on the evaluations:**
