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#### 2. DBM News

- a) Our Scholarly Qualification Guidelines have been updated. Is online on SDUnet.dk
- b) Nicole F. Richter is 1 of 3 finalists for the 2023 HR Research Award. The winner of the award will be finally decided at the CRANET conference in March 2023.
- c) As informed SDU will start with waste sorting. Individual trash bins will not be emptied by cleaning staff anymore and you should use the new waste stations just outside the department. If you choose to keep the bin in your office, you are to empty your trash yourself.

- e) Elke Weik has been elected new union representative, Djøf, and replaces Karsten.
- f) The arrangement with fruit will end in April and SDU will not continue it. It is part of a financial contingency plan as we look at financial uncertainty as regards to lower numbers of student enrollment and uncertainty about the taximeter (subsidy from the State). The SDU board of directors decided in December 2022 that the controlled continency plan means a 1.5% reduction of costs from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023. This corresponds to approx. 600,000 DKK at the department. Dannie stressed that there is no reason for panicking when he looks at the department's financial situation. We have many things going on that could increase income and reduce costs.
- g) Niklas Woermann informed that there is a suspicion that some students have used AI / ChatGPT during the current exams. Using AI is qualified as plagiarism and do you suspect AI has been used, please report it. Use your gut feeling and your experience and let students know that it is not tolerated.
- h) Mette Lund Kristensen informed that she will invite to a session about how to carry out group supervisions. If anyone wants to share good ideas on how to do group supervision, please let her know to use as good examples and inspiration. The session will take 1-2 hours and participation is voluntary.

Mette also informed that she sometimes hears about student asking difficult questions or not following the "normal" code of conduct. We, therefore, have made a draft of a DBM code of conduct with certain information about interaction between students and teacher. It can serve as a mean to orchestra your classes showing what you expect of them and what they can expect of you. Mette sends out the documents for your input.
