#### 4. DBM News

#### **DBM Economy**

Dannie gave an overview of the financial situation at the department. It is expected that the department will end with a deficit this year, and a deficit is also expected in 2025. Hereafter, there is a positive trend, even though we cannot foresee what will happen as we still await the reform of the cand. merc. and there will also be a reduction of bachelor students.

Dannie explained that the income level in the budget is based on projections with a delay of 1.5 year.

Dannie reminded everyone to hand in timesheets for projects, to be able to use the grants according to the project budgets. We also would like to avoid sending back any grants we have not used. External funding plays and will play an important part of the DBM economy.

#### **AACBS**

- Research assistants to be teamed up with researchers as AACSB requires that teaching is conducted with employees with research backgrounds.
- In June 2025 the AACSB peer review will visit us and will focus on those areas they found problematic at the latest meeting.

#### **Lifelong Learning**

- Marianne Harbo Frederiksen is part of the faculty's Task Force on how to develop lifelong learning. With the reform of cand. merc, this work is very important.
- SDU management has decided to close SDUx in Vejle. SDUx was an experiment in developing new forms for lifelong learning in collaboration with industries.

#### Areas of thought leadership

• 17 June – inspiration day from 10-12. The first hour will be a faculty event online followed by a one hour departmental activity event also online. There will be a follow up at the August seminar.

#### 5. HA reform update by Tina Lundø Tranekjer

Transferring the old HA reform to a new one involved establishment of two committees, the practice committee and innovation committee. Tina thanked everyone involved.

Tina headed the Practice Committee and the two committees had a joint meeting a few weeks back where the findings were presented to the Business School Management.

From April to August – discussions and final development of a new HA curriculum is to be developed. Tina is also part of this team together with Mette Lund Kristensen and Hans Frimor from IVI + malene Damsted and Mette Søgaard Nielsen from IEB.

Outstanding things discussed: which criteria are the new HA reform to be built upon and some criteria are fixed by the faculty. Change of content or should HA look like it is and if we change a lot we will have to apply for a new accreditation. Two departments now own HA (the Business School) instead of four departments.





Slagelse Map: Only automatic fire alarm in teaching areas, call out on all

floors

Kolding: Automatic fire alam with speaking connecting

automatically to the firefighting service + sprinkler

system

## **Emergency Procedure on SDU**

- > Evacuation Stand with evacuation equipment
- > The evacuation leader (Yellow jacket)
  - > Make sure people leave the building
  - > Give the assembly point manager a status report at the assembly point.
- > The assembly point leader (Orange jacket)
  - > Overall responsibility for establishing the assembly point for evacuees
  - > Inform about result of the evacuation to the police/fire service and for reporting back to evacuees
