The impact of the project in relation to engagement with society	<i>Describe the impact of the project – in particular in relation to value creation and societal/business activities within companies and organizations in the public and private sectors.</i>
Success criteria (KPIs)	<i>Which indicators will determine that the project has been successful and has delivered the expected results – in particular with respect to Translational research and engagement with health and society?</i>
Potential of the project	<i>What is the long term perspective of the project e.g. with respect to implementation of results?</i>
External Stakeholders	<i>External Stakeholders involved in the project.</i>
Funding from the Discovery Funds – 50%	<i>Amount of requested funding from the initiative and line of reasoning therefore. (Detailed budget should be included as an appendix – using the SDU budget template)</i>

Co-financing from department/faculty – 50%	<i>Indicate who will provide co-financing, and which expenses are covered by means of co-financing.</i>
External gearing	<i>In order to be considered for funding a valid plan on how to attract external funding matching a gearing of 2:3 must be presented. The plan must include which external funding has been or will be applied for and when – and it must be described how the expected external gearing comes into play in the project. For high risk funding, please describe alternative financing opportunities for external funding. The plan can be attached as enclosure.</i>
Confirmation from partners (head of department(s) / dean(s))	<i>Partners from OUH, psychiatry and SDU, who provide co-financing for the project should sign and accept the conditions of co-financing.</i>
