NORDIC CENTRE AT FUDAN UNIVERSITY
AUTUMN 2026**

Researchers at Nordic Centre member universities can apply for funding to organize academic events such as research seminars, workshops, courses, or conferences at the Nordic Centre at Fudan University in Shanghai.

FUNDING FOR ACADEMIC EVENTS

Grant amount: Between 2,000 and 6,000 euros

Application deadline: September 20, 2026

Priority will be given to applications:

- A) Involve at least two Nordic Centre member universities, preferably from different Nordic countries
- B) Include one or more Chinese partners, with particular priority given to events involving Fudan University or affiliated members of the Nordic Centre. Other Chinese universities are warmly welcome to join as additional partners.
- C) That align to one or several of the [prioritized thematic areas](#) for Sino-Nordic collaboration at the Nordic Centre, including but not exclusive to: sustainable development, climate research, digital social solutions, aging, food culture and security, comparative welfare systems, the Arctic, heritage studies.

We especially encourage activities that can serve as a networking platform for early career researchers and can facilitate new connections between Nordic and Chinese scholars; that have the potential to result in joint applications for larger external grants and are open for participation/contributions from all the Nordic Centre member institutions.
