



**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS:
FUNDING FOR ACADEMIC EVENTS
NORDIC CENTRE AT FUDAN UNIVERSITY
SPRING 2026**

Researchers at Nordic Centre member universities can apply for funding to organize academic events such as research seminars, workshops, courses, or conferences at the Nordic Centre at Fudan University in Shanghai.

Grant amount: Between 2,000 and 6,000 euros

Application deadline: March 20, 2026

Priority will be given to applications:

- A) That include the participation of at least two Nordic [member universities](#), preferably from different Nordic countries, and one or more Chinese members (including affiliate).
- B) Where Fudan University or Chinese affiliated members are among the partners, other Chinese universities are more than welcome to be involved as partners, and this priority should not be taken as a as a mandatory condition.
- C) That relate to one or several of the [prioritized thematic areas](#) for Sino-Nordic collaboration at the Nordic Centre, including but not exclusive to: sustainable development, climate research, digital social solutions, aging, food culture and security, comparative welfare systems, the Arctic, heritage studies.

We especially encourage activities that can serve as a networking platform for early career researchers and can facilitate new connections between Nordic and Chinese scholars; that have the potential to result in joint applications for larger external grants and are open for participation/contributions from all the Nordic Centre member institutions.
