Employment of Non-EU Citizens Starting 1 February 2026

We encourage you to submit requests for employment starting on 1 February 2026 to the HR consultants no later than 10 December 2025 to ensure time for the application of a residence and work permit and that it will be granted before the employment starts.



Work Permits for D-VIP Employment (e.g., External Examiners)

Before requesting employment of a D-VIP from a non-EU/EEA country, please notify ISO to ensure the individual has the correct work permit. This also applies to tasks remunerated with an honorarium.

Such tasks typically fall under the category of 'secondary employment,' for example, if the person is employed by another Danish employer. In some cases, this requires a separate work permit for secondary employment, which ISO can assist in applying for.

Processing time is approximately one month, and the application is free of charge. Work must **not** begin before the permit has been granted.

This also applies when international SDU employees perform such tasks at other universities. In these cases, we encourage the individual to contact the relevant university. You can refer them to the page on Rules of Sideline employment on SDUnet.
